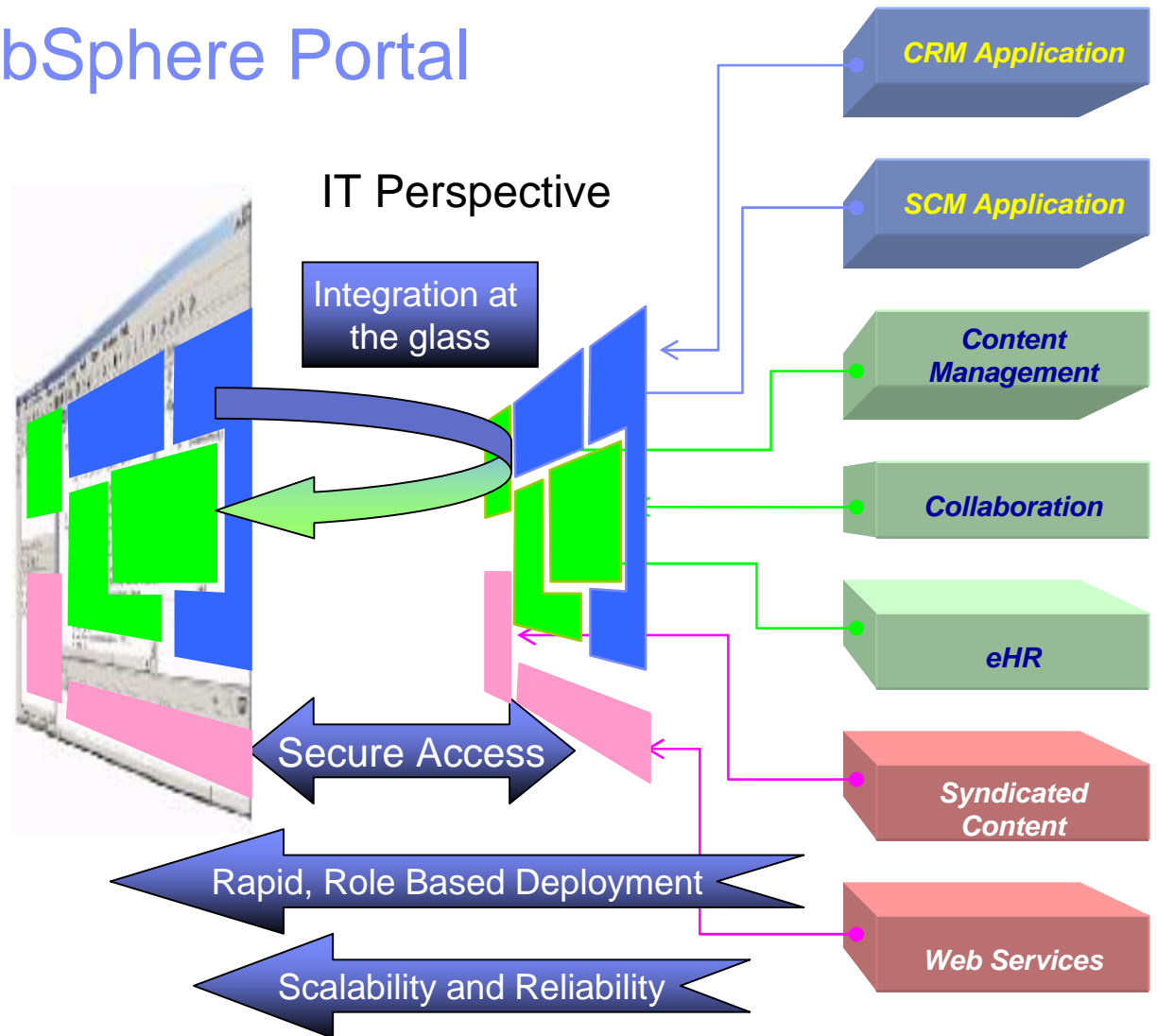

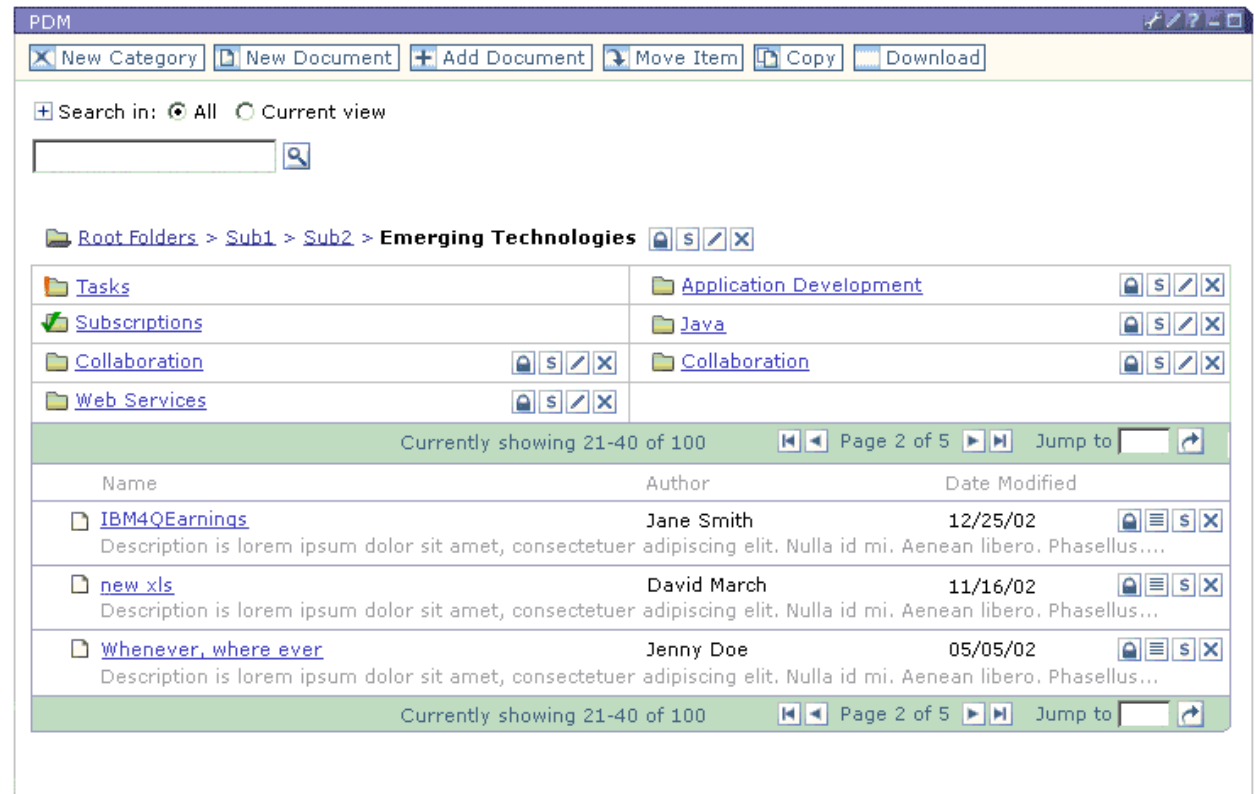

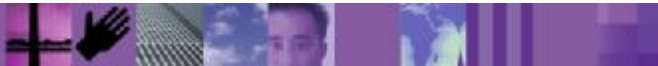
## Portal Standards Initiatives (delivered in refresh)

### § Portlet API: <http://jcp.org/jsr/detail/168.jsp>

- Achieves Interoperability between local Portlets and Portals
- Standardization via Java Community Process, co-led by IBM and Sun
- IBM will provide the reference implementation; Sun will edit the spec and provide the compliance test kit

### § Portlet Web Services: [https://www.oasis-open.org/news/oasis\\_news\\_01\\_28\\_02.shtml](https://www.oasis-open.org/news/oasis_news_01_28_02.shtml)

- Achieves Interoperability between visual web services and portals
- Standardization vis OASIS, led by IBM
- IBM leads workgroup and will provide reference implementation





## Portlet Co-operation

- § Key principle: the portal server aggregates applications together into one unified presentation while delivering a highly personalized experience to every user
- § This is really user-oriented process integration or *integration on the glass*
- § To achieve this, we need “portlet co-operation” where portlets work together to present the user with a unified view



# User-driven Process Integration: Click to Action

*Helps users connect applications more easily.*

*Clicking in one portlet sends data to others; works by matching data types to portlet actions.*

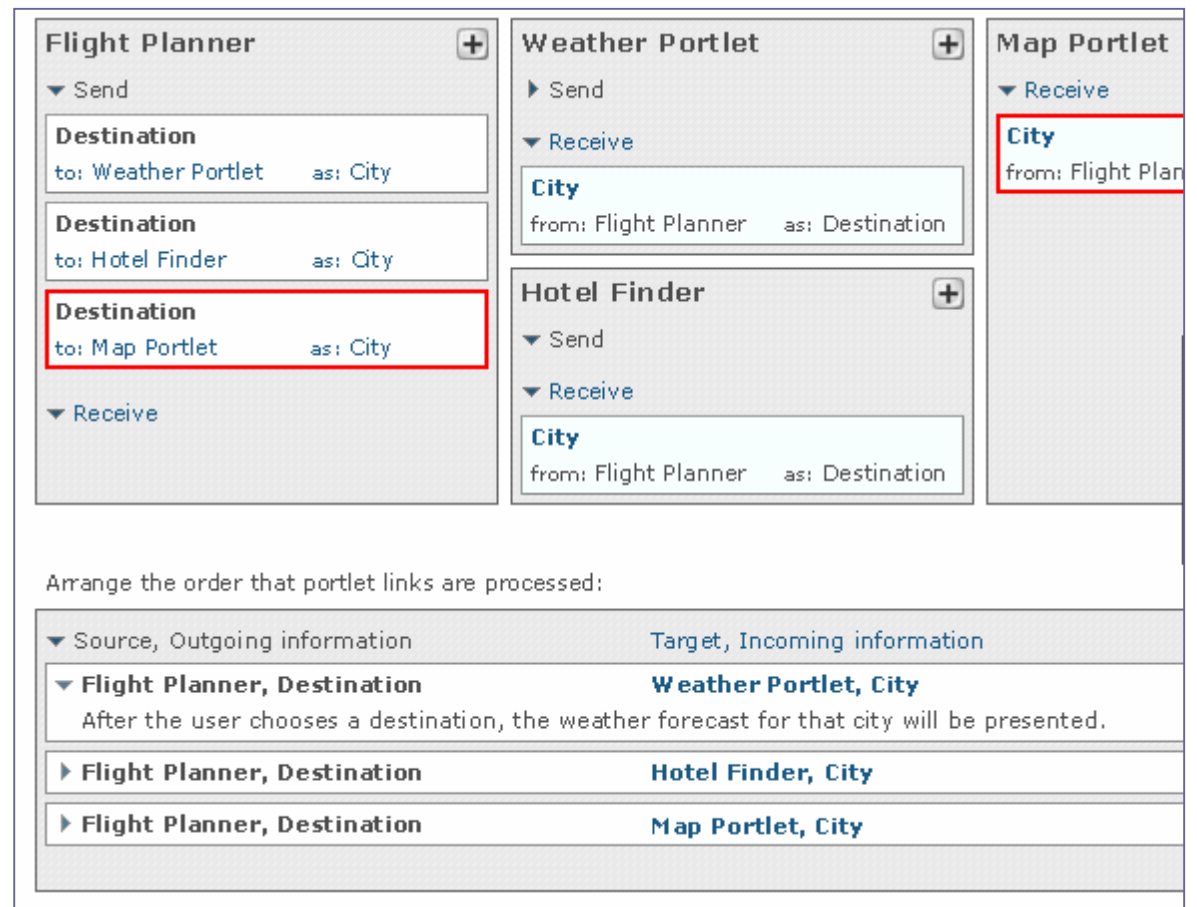
# User-driven Process Integration: Cooperative Portlets

– portlet messaging enables rich portlet applications

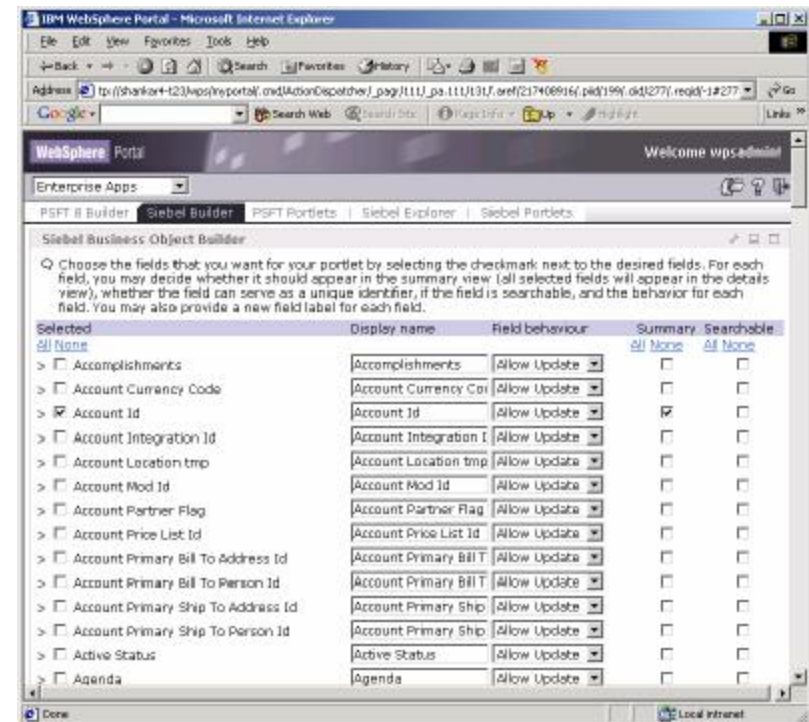
§ Builds on Click to Action and portlet API for portlet-to-portlet communication

§ Uses Property Broker component



## Additional Portlet Builders

- § JDBC Builder – Create portlets that display and update data from a database (DB2, Oracle, SQL Server, etc.)
- § Domino Builder – Builds portlets for Domino/Notes databases

## § Collaboration Center

- For enterprises that seek to extend web portal infrastructure with a pre-built e-Workplace solution.

## § Includes New Portlets

- People Finder – On-line company directory with built-in instant messaging and people awareness
- My eMeetings – View, schedule and attend Sametime e-meetings
- My Quickplaces – Display, search and launch Quickplace project team rooms

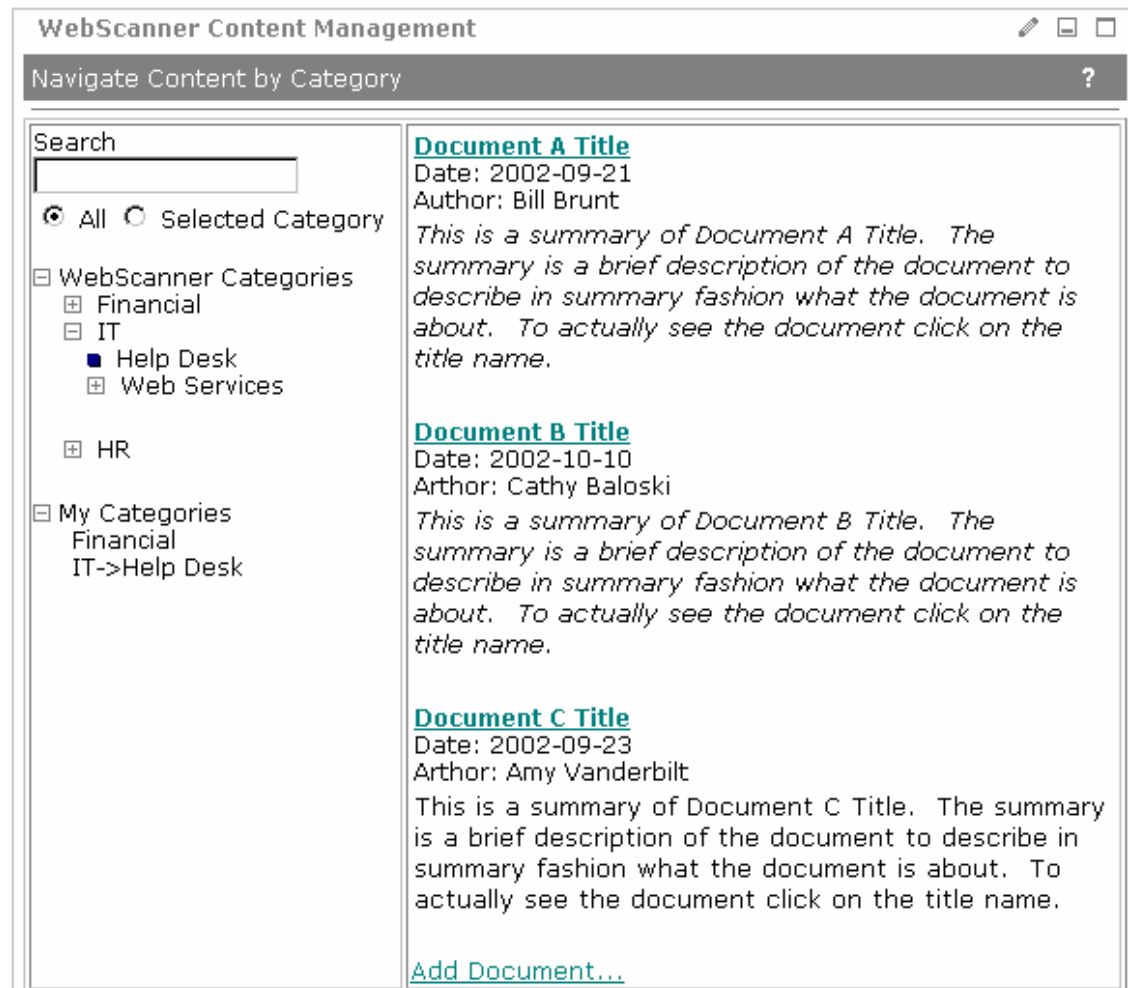

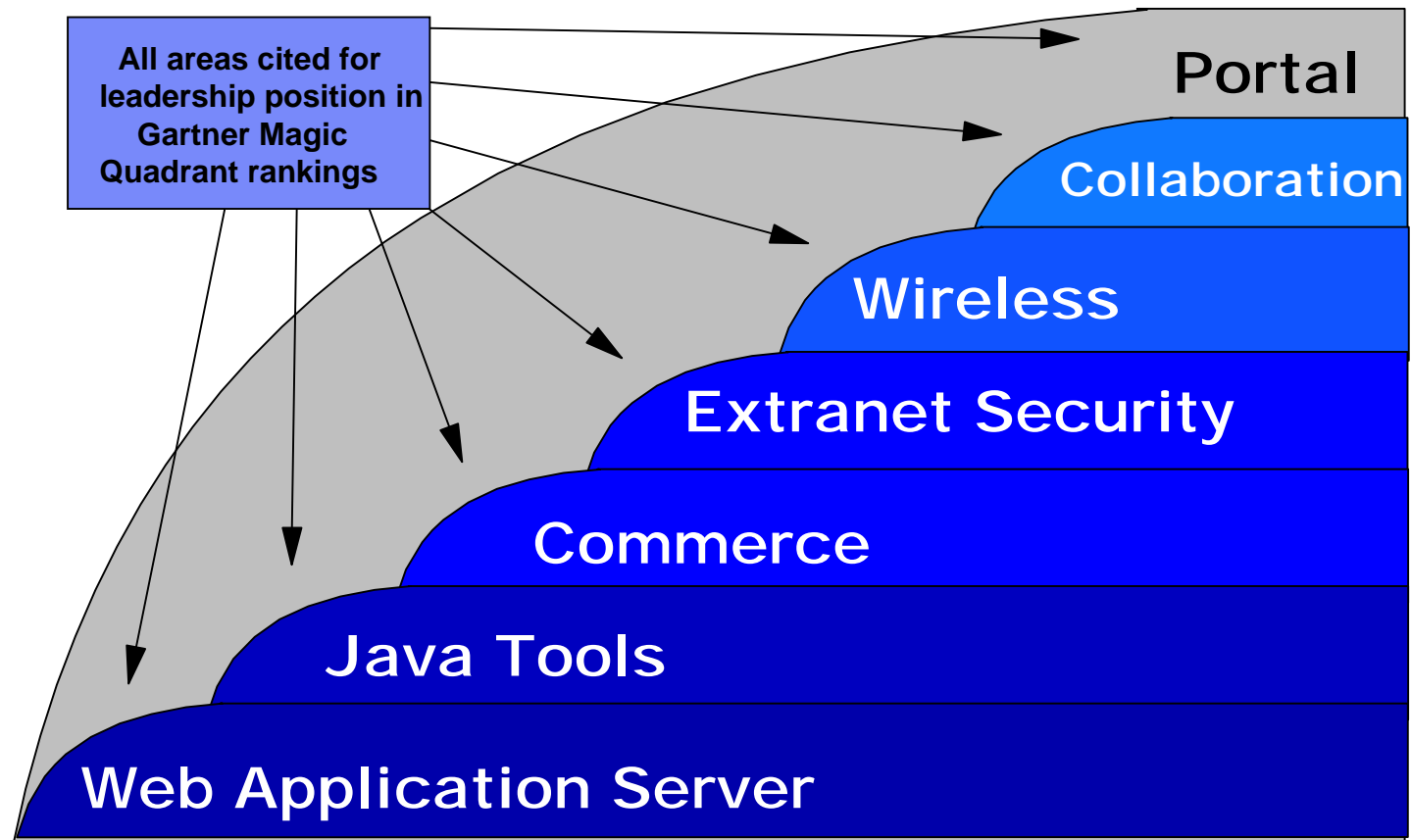

- § Part of Portal Search Engine
- § Crawl websites for documents based on filters and categories
- § Select approved documents for inclusion in the search index
- § Document security
  - Encode user group and role information into the document before indexing
  - Search results are filtered by role/group info

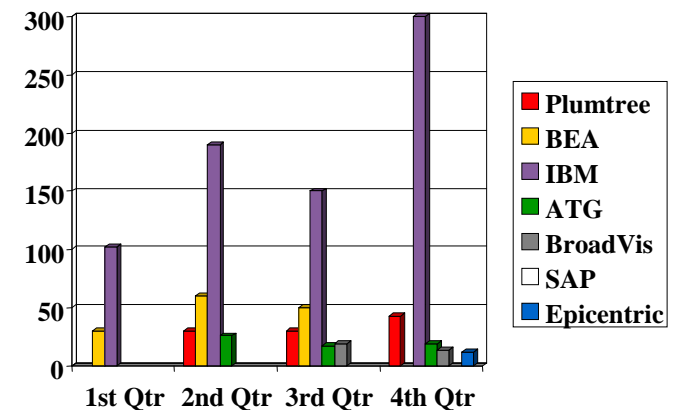

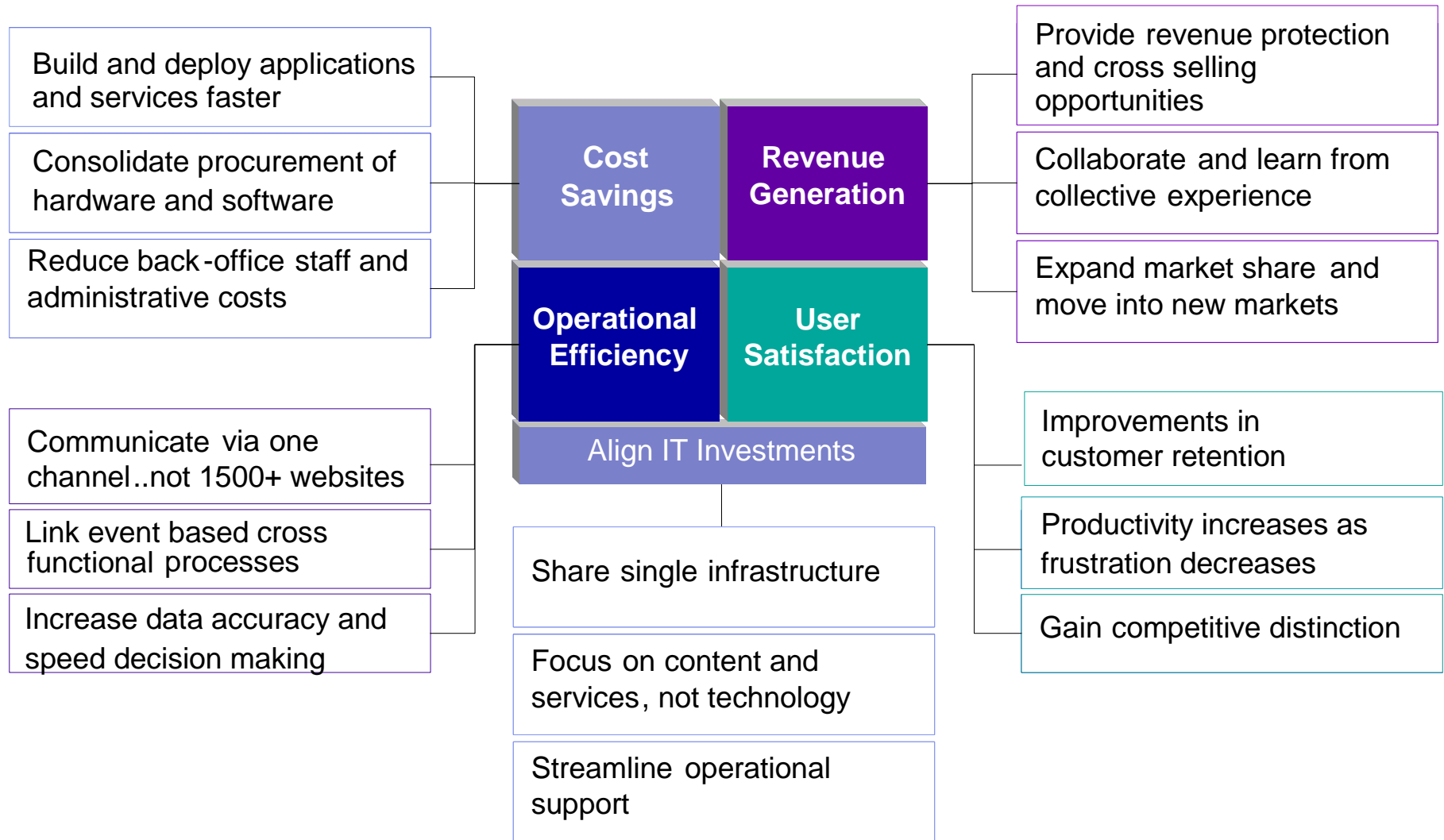
